

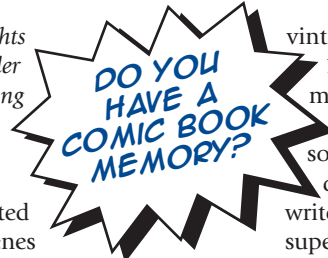

Celebrate 350 Jewish Life in America 1654 - 2004

In Atlanta!

September 2004 marks the nation-wide celebration of 350 years of Jewish settlement in America. The arrival in September 1654 of twenty-three penniless refugees from Brazil fleeing the long arm of the Inquisition was the beginning of what would become the most vibrant, successful and important Diaspora community in all of Jewish history. The Breman is honored to plan and coordinate the programs and events that will take place in Atlanta.

Through October 31, a large panel exhibition organized by the Jewish Theological Seminary will be on display in several institutions around the city. The exhibition, entitled "Treasures of Americana," includes facsimile prints from the JTS library that illustrate the rich history of American Jewry. Venues include the Marcus JCC—Zaban Park, Congregation Kol Emeth, Ahavath Achim Synagogue, The Temple and The Selig Center. A catalog of the exhibition will be for sale in The Breman Museum Gift Shop.

Atlanta Interfaith Broadcasters (AIB) has generously partnered with The Breman to produce a series of short segments, each portraying "A Moment in 350 Years of American

Living History: The Survivor Portrait Project

This summer we have been joined by four bright and committed college students who are crafting biographical narratives of the Holocaust Survivors who speak to student groups at The Breman. The students participating in this special project are Avi Goldman from Brandeis University, Erin Mazursky from Georgetown University, Kathryn R. Smith from Agnes Scott College, and Eryk Tahvonen from Georgia State University.

Under the direction of Dr. Lili Baxter and supervised by museum educators Sara Ghitis, Melanie Mazursky and Nancy Pollard, these college students learn about the Holocaust through researching and writing these profiles.

Each Survivor Portrait will depict in words and pictures the personal story of a survivor's life and will include the lessons they wish to pass on to future generations.

This new take-home learning tool will be presented to the nearly 20,000 students (grades 5–12) who come to The Breman every school year to tour our signature exhibition, *Absence of Humanity: The Holocaust Years, 1933–1945*.

Those students also have the unique opportunity to hear a Holocaust survivor tell her or his eyewitness account of the Holocaust years.

It is The Breman's hope that these Survivor Portraits will encourage dialogue about a difficult subject among student visitors, teachers and parents. Survivor Portraits will also be a permanent legacy for our speakers' families and for all of us.

The Survivor Portrait Project is made possible by generous grants from the Jewish Community Endowment Fund of the Jewish Federation of Greater Atlanta and the IECA Foundation.

Looking Back: The 2003–2004 School Year in Numbers

- Museum Educators guided 623 tours.
- Speakers told their personal stories about the Holocaust 276 times.

COMPARED TO LAST SCHOOL YEAR:

- Number of tours up by 13%.

NEW PROJECTS & INITIATIVES:

- The Breman participated in **VSA (Vision–Strength–Access) Arts of Georgia**, providing free access to The Breman for people with disabilities and those who are economically disadvantaged. Eighteen groups came to The Breman this year through this national program.
- **Women of Valor: The Legacy Quilt**, honoring eleven Jewish women who made a difference in Atlanta, has traveled to more than ten venues since its spring debut. The creation of this magnificent quilt was spearheaded by Breman volunteer Pat Pugrant.

New Acquisitions Bring Public and Private Lives to Light

does the personality of Jacob Elsas, one of Atlanta's most prominent early citizens. His letters shed light on the day-to-day operations of the mill, as well as on his personal life, as is evidenced in the following excerpt from a letter addressed to his sons Louis and Victor on January 23, 1900:

My Dear Sons Louis & Victor –

I must know whether the amounts arranged for during last summer's vacation will be ample, as I want to remit Mr. Ehrlich every three months the amount you will require. You will now notify me whether you have enough for the first quarter of the year, since you were considerably overdrawn up to January 1st.

Eugene has just sent me report that he spent quite a large amount during his stay in Boston and that Mr. Ehrlich advanced him \$80.00. I cannot understand how he could have spent that much money in a few weeks, and I am more astonished that you did not restrict him as you know very well that at such rate I could not let him remain in school.

This wonderful letter stands the test of time, as it could have been written by a 21st century parent to a child away at school. What else can

we learn from this letter? The social historian and researcher might be intrigued by how well a first generation immigrant from Germany had mastered the English language. Another researcher might find that this letter, when read with others in the collection, provides heretofore unknown insight into Jacob Elsas' relationship with his sons.

Each collection expands our knowledge of Jewish life in Georgia and complements the 2000 manuscript collections, 15,000 photographs, 500 oral histories, and numerous newspapers and microfilm reels already housed at the museum.

The Cuba Archives serves our community by safeguarding these treasures, making these materials available to researchers.

Make time to drop by The Breman to see the Dolls for Democracy, on display in the lobby of the Selig Center.

The Ida Pearle and Joseph Cuba Community Archives of The Breman has recently accessioned several new collections.

Items include Dolls For Democracy, a seventeen-piece set of hand-made figures created by B'nai B'rith Women to teach good citizenship to school children in the 1950s; photographs and documents relating to the career of Harry Weissman, farm manager at the Federal Government Honor Prison Farm in Decatur in the 1940s; a 1907 photograph of the offices of the Fulton Bag and Cotton Mill; and a letter copy book, 1888–1913, containing the private correspondence of Jacob Elsas, the founder of Fulton Mills.

Through these collections, the civic responsibility of B'nai B'rith Women in the 1950s and 1960s once more comes to life, as

Rae Alice and Bernard Cohen Memorial Fund Established to Support Archives

In 1985, the project that has grown to become The Breman's Ida Pearle & Joseph Cuba Archives and Genealogy Center was just getting off the ground. Everyone who was involved at that time surely remembers that Rae Alice Cohen, with the encouragement of her husband Bernard, was one of the volunteers most dedicated to ensuring that this effort would be successful.

Passionate about our community's history, possessing a wonderful memory of Jewish community happenings, and fully understanding the urgency of preserving the materials and photographs which illuminate the Jewish experience in Atlanta and in Georgia, Rae Alice involved herself in every aspect of identifying potential sources and collecting from donors. She spent hours helping to process collections—a time-consuming, meticulous, often tedious, but vital activity for the archives.

In honoring their parents, the children of Rae Alice and Bernard, Dayl Cohen of Cambridge,

Massachusetts, Dr. Perry Cohen and Rosalie Mandelbaum of Washington, DC, and Alan and Pam Cohen of Atlanta have given a \$100,000 gift

for the creation of The Rae Alice and Bernard Cohen Memorial Fund to support the continuing operations and growth of the archives. The Fund will be used to acquire, process, preserve and conserve new objects and materials for The Breman's Archives.

The Breman is grateful to the family of Rae Alice and Bernard for choosing to honor their parents by creating a fund that will grow

throughout the years and increase in its capacity to support the preservation of our community's memory.

Breman Library Offers Extensive Resources

Among the many holdings available to researchers and educators at The Breman are a wonderful research library, an extensive video collection and valuable teacher resources.

The library houses a collection of books and subject files on topics focused on the Holocaust and Southern Jewish history, including

Resilience and Courage: Women, Men and the Holocaust, by Nechama Tec

In this, Nechama Tec's fifth book on the Holocaust, vivid individual stories blend effortlessly with detailed comparisons of wartime experiences of women and men. The result is a gripping account of the distinct coping strategies and ultimate fate of each gender.



European Jewish history, Jewish literature, and children's books of all types.

The merger of The Breman with the Jewish Genealogical Society of Georgia is bolstering the library's genealogical resources, and an on-line computer system with genealogy applications and databases will soon be available.

The Breman's video collection contains hundreds of titles on topics ranging from general history to basic Judaism, and includes tapes for children explaining Jewish holidays. Videos on the subject of the Holocaust include testimonies of local survivors.

DVDs, VHS tapes, audiocassettes, and CD-ROMS can be checked out for use in the home or classroom.

The Breman Museum Library, in conjunction with the Weinberg Center for Holocaust Education, is also currently developing an extensive set of teaching materials on a variety of subjects relating to the Holocaust and diversity issues. These easy-to-use teaching modules include lesson plans, videos and/or books—all designed to help kindergarten through high school teachers prepare meaningful learning experiences for their students.

Comic books have had a huge impact on American popular culture and, especially during the Golden Age, were very reflective of many socio-economic, social justice and political issues of the day.

Throughout the 1930s and 1940s and into the early 1950s, the Super Heroes were the champions of the common man and the defenders of America's freedoms and ideals.

Superman first appeared in 1938 and was soon followed by other National Periodical Comics (now DC Comics) creations, including *Batman* (1939), *Green Lantern* (1941), and *Wonder Woman* (1941).

Fawcett Publications offered *Captain Marvel* (1940); Quality Comics produced *Uncle Sam* (1940), the *Human Torch* (1939) and *Sub-Mariner* (1939); and *Captain America* (1941) was published by Timely Comics (now the Marvel Comics Group).

Guest curator for **ZAP! POW! BAM!** is Jerry Robinson who, while working with Bob Kane on *Batman*, named Robin, Batman's young protégé. Robinson also co-created *The Joker*, Batman's nemesis and one of the first Super-Villains.

Mr. Robinson's many years of experience in the comic book industry; his numerous connections to current comic book authors, artists and collectors; and his vision have been invaluable in the creation of an exclusive and exciting look at the Golden Age of comic books.

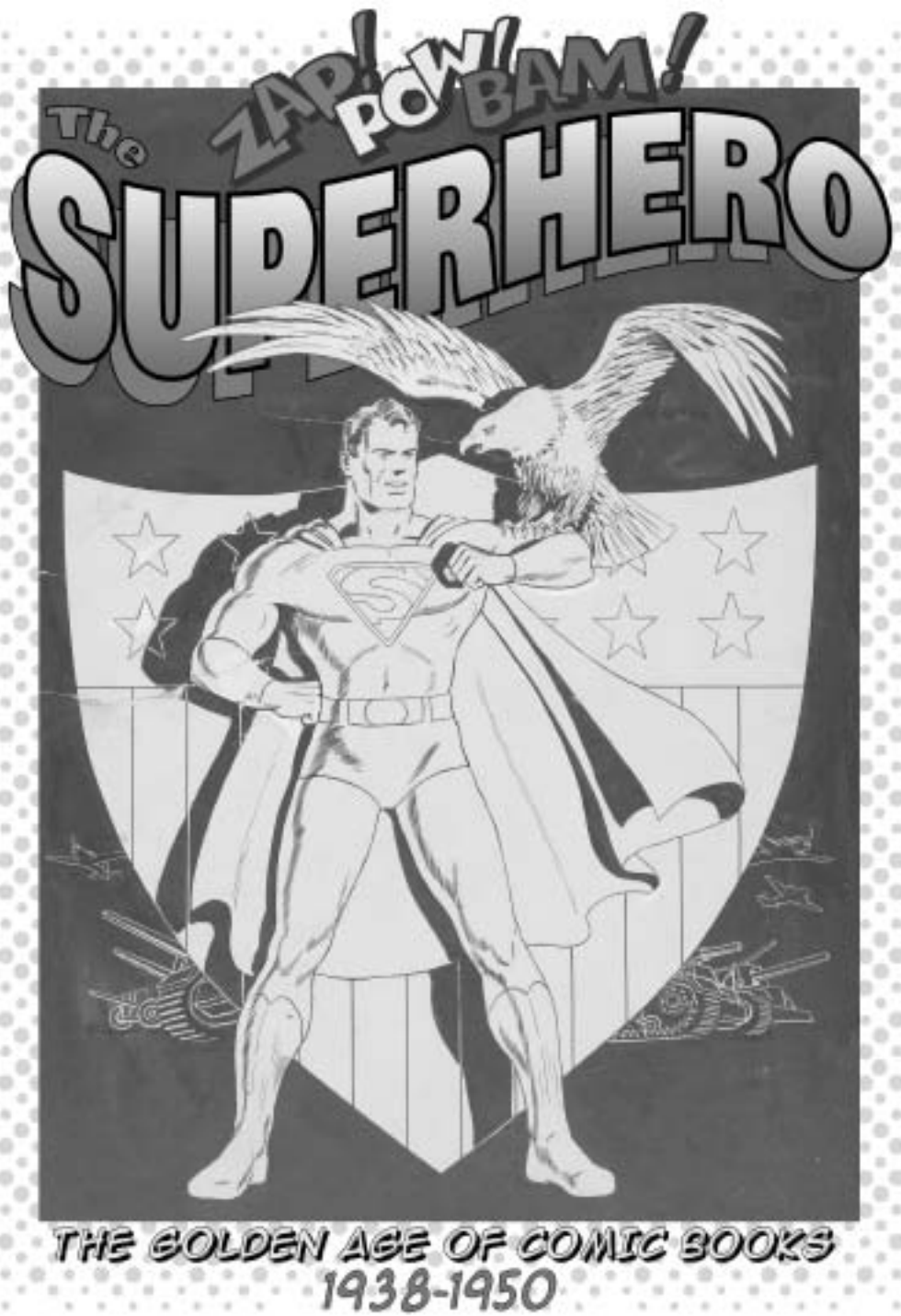

Comments From an Osborne High School Teacher . . .

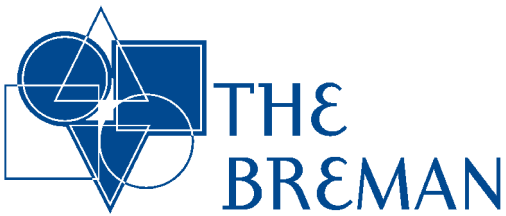
Dear Judi, [Judi Ayal, Visitor's Services]
