Teachers Guide: Five Lesson Unit for Grades 5 - 12*

Lesson 1: Establishing Historical Context

Students will be provided with historical background on the Holocaust, and will learn about major events, people and places.

Lesson 2: Viewing and Discussing *Daniel's Story*

Students will view the film *Remember the Children: Daniel's Story* (13 min.), and discuss images and statements that made an impression on them in the context of what they are learning about the Holocaust.

Lesson 3: Preparing to Visit The Breman

Students will view the film **Holocaust Gallery Video** and review what to expect and how to conduct themselves during the museum visit.

Lesson 4: Visiting The Breman

Students will take a guided tour of The Breman's exhibition, *Absence of Humanity: The Holocaust Years, 1933 – 1945*, and hear a Holocaust speaker tell his or her own story.

Lesson 5: Post-Visit Discussion

Students will review what they have learned about the Holocaust from their visit to The Breman, and will read and sign their Holocaust **Portraits**.
