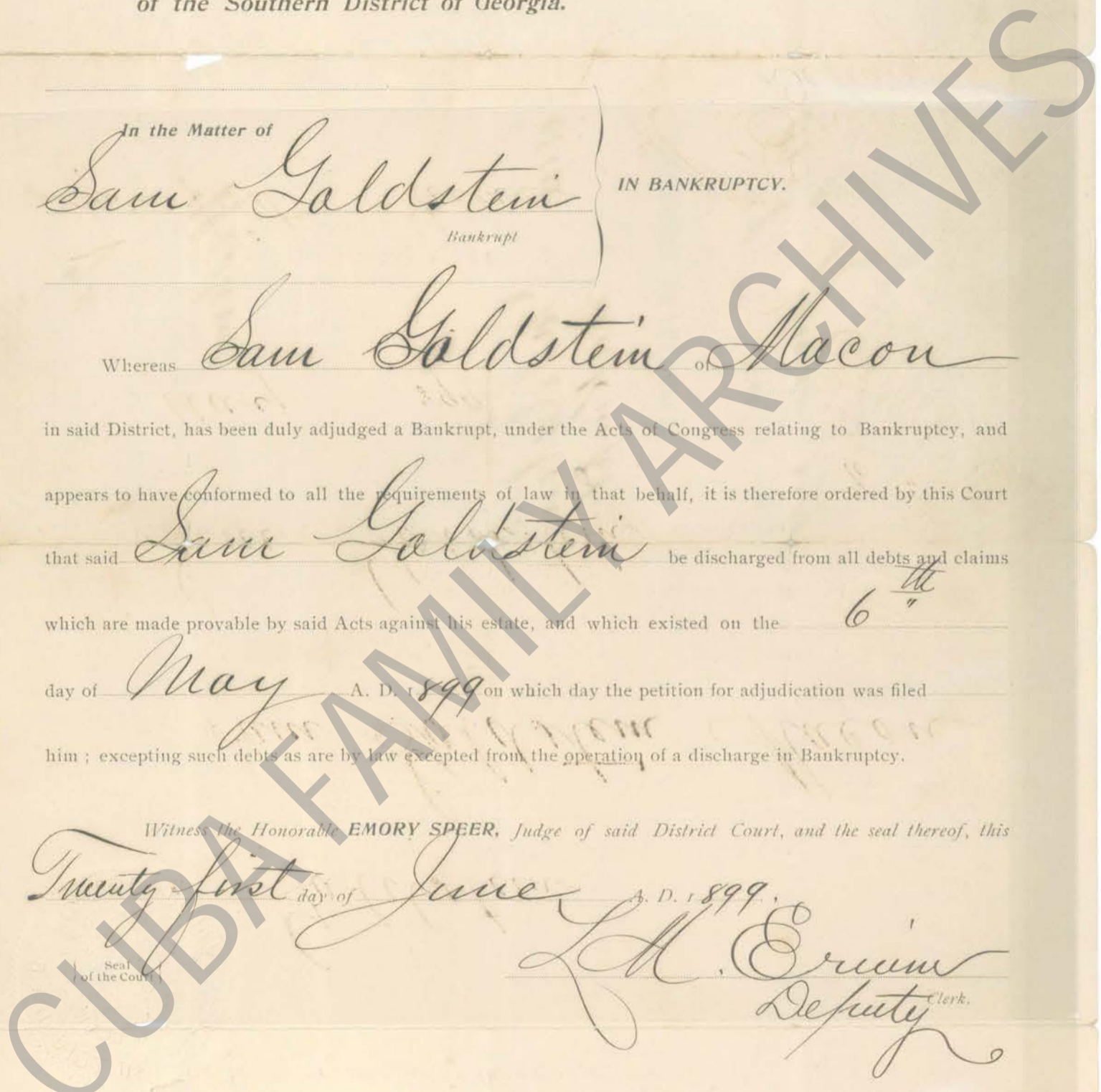
Whereas Sam Goldstein of Macon
