Know All Whom It May Concern

That on the 30th day of July 1945, the last Will and Testament of JACK BENJAMIN GORDON, JR., deceased, at the time of his death a resident of said County, was legally proven in common form, a copy of which is annexed, duly certified, and on the 30th day of July 1945, at a regular ----- Term of the Court of Ordinary, said Will was admitted to record by order, and Mrs. Sadie Goldstein Gordon named Executrix in said Will, allowed to qualify, and upon so doing, Letters Testamentary ordered to be issued to her as such Executrix.

Now, Therefore, The said Mrs. Sadie Goldstein Gordon having taken the oath of office, and complied with all the necessary prerequisites of the law, is legally authorized to discharge all the duties of an Executrix on the Will of said deceased, to administer the property of said deceased, which is devised according to the Will and the law; and is hereby required to render a true and perfect inventory and appraisement of all and singular the goods and chattels, rights and credits, of said deceased, and make a return of them to the Ordinary of Fulton County, and further, to report annually to the same officer of the situation of said estate, actings and doings, until ----- Executorship is fully discharged. -
